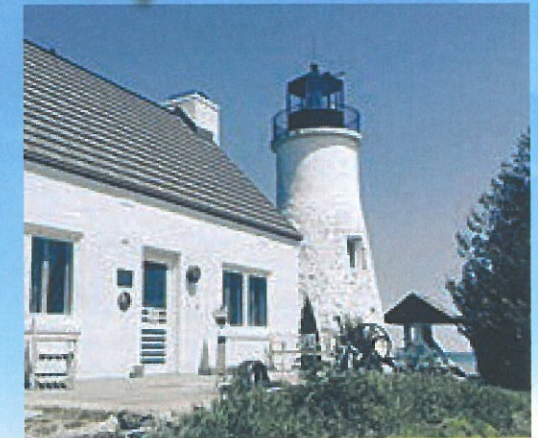

The Range Light Park

5779 E. Grand Lake Rd. Presque Isle, Michigan

This park has a public walkway that leads to a picnic pavilion, which is handicap accessible. Bring your suit and enjoy the beautiful sandy beach.



The 1870 Front Range Light is located in the park. The Rear Light is across the road and is privately owned.

When approaching the harbor, mariners align the two lights, one above the other, and continue on the line to safe anchorage.
