Presque Isle Township Fire Board meeting held October 04, 2017

Members present: Dick Nowak, Paul Borg, Bernie Andrzejewski, and Ryan Bueter.

The following motions were made by the Fire Board:

Motion for request to purchase of a safe to hold petty cash to be installed at the Fire Station for up to \$250. The money will come from the Equipment Maintenance and Repair line (206-300-930-000) of the Fire Department Budget.

Motion made by Paul Borg seconded by Bernie Andrzejewski.

Motion was approved with 4 votes for and no votes against.

Motion for moving the Storage Shed closer to the Fire Station building. We will wait until the floor in the shed is fixed before moving it. Help to move the shed is welcome.

Motion for request to purchase 6 EMS Responder Coats for \$1500. The money will come from the Equipment line (206-300-730-000) of the Fire Department Budget.

Motion for request to purchase of 4 pairs of Boots and 4 pairs of Gloves for \$1004. The money will come from the Equipment line (206-300-730-000) of the Fire Department Budget.

Motion was approved with 4 votes for and no votes against.

Chief Bill Forbush announced that there will be an open house on Saturday October 14 at the Presque Isle Fire Department Fire Station at 24335 US 23 South, celebrating Fire Prevention Week. It will be held from 2:00 pm until 4:00 pm.

Four other notes are that:

- Training was held at the Presque Isle Township Fire Station for Fire Departments in Presque Isle County for the new 800 Mega Hertz radios being issued by the County. The radios will be going into service soon.

- The Rescue Truck has been outfitted with equipment and is now in service.
- Bob Adrian has picked up fire hose, ladders, and many other items donated by a Fire Truck refurbishing company near Lansing, Michigan. Bob was assisted by Dick Nowak and Paul Borg travelling to and loading the donated equipment that was brought back.
- Bob Adrian and Andy Williams went to Midland and brought back more donated equipment (Jaws of life, cutters, and spreaders)
