ARPA Funds Recommendations: The Parks and Recreation Committee has been asked to provide recommendations to the Board of Trustees on how best to allocate \$108,000 in ARPA funding which needs to be committed by the end of 2024. The committee considered the results of the 2022 resident survey in their discussion. The projects that were deliberated:         • Walking trail: The committee will recommend allocating \$70,000 for a walking trail across from the Township Hall.         • New Lighthouse parking lot: The committee will recommend allocating \$30,000 for a new parking lot at the New Lighthouse.         • Shooting range: The committee will recommend a potential collaboration with the Grand Lake Sportsmen's Club.         • Playground at Range Light: The committee will recommend a Range Light playground with any remaining funds.         • Pickleball court: The committee concluded that an outdoor pickleball court would be of limited use due to the local climate. The point was made that there is already a pickleball court in the Township Hall gym. Efforts will be made to promote that court on social media.         • Township Hall ventilation: The Township Hall currently has a ventilation system in place that isn't being utilized.         Signage for Overflow Parking: Committee members
discussed the possibility of signage that would direct Old
Lighthouse visitors to park in the DNR parking lot when the lighthouse is closed. The committee is now looking into
moving the gate back to create after-hours parking on
Township property instead.
